Haiti – Though a trip is set for March 20-27 and another for September 20-27, due to the recent earthquake we will certainly be adding some Disaster Relief trips as soon as we receive clearance to send teams. Fees may change, trip focus will certainly change from VBS and babies to more construction, rehab, care and counseling, medical teams, etc. We have nothing firm to report right now except that we WILL be needing people to GO and HELP sometime in the months ahead. Three million people without shelter, 50,000 killed- Haiti needs the Body of Christ more than ever. Keep an eye on the worship folder for up-to-date news!

Uganda – July 2010 – est. \$3000 – Fresh after the 2009 New Life Christmas Offering to purchase land for Mukono Community Church (MCC), New Life will return to Uganda in July to build upon our partnership with Africa Renewal Ministries and MCC. In addition to commemorating the church land purchase and water line installation, we will assess the possibility of child sponsorships, provide training in targeted areas, and build up the community around MCC with the Hope of the Gospel. In addition, we plan to return to Gulu to partner with Sports Outreach Ministry and to visit Romu, where New Life previously donated a water well. Specific dates of the trip will be finalized by the end of January. Yellow fever and additional inoculations are needed and travel is long and intense. Accommodations will be “western” and safe - but spartan. Adults 18+ are welcome to join us in God's work in Africa.
