Read Philippians 4:8-9.

DAY 3

Read Psalm 119:97-104.

Getting God's word INTO us makes us able to be THAT person, the one who has the wise answer no one else does, who's strong enough to do the right thing when the whole world's watching, who comes through when it matters most. You've heard the phrase "Christ-like"? This is what that's all about.

DAY 2

Read Ephesians 2:10.
Then read Philippians 1:6.
